Department of Education are to deliver formal designated senior lead for mental health training as part of a national programme to those identified, this is planned to start in 20/21.</p>
<p><b>2. The number of Mental Health Support Teams</b></p>	<p>Two mental health support teams in Buckinghamshire</p>
<p><b>3. Plans (if any) to trial a four week waiting time for access to specialist NHS children and young people’s mental health services</b></p>	<p>Buckinghamshire are a wave 1 trailblazer site and as such are currently trialling 4 week wait time initiatives within their specialist Child and Adolescent Mental Health Services CAMHS provision</p>
