As policies, protocols or guidance can change quickly in the NHS, Buks CCG via Clarity TeamNet will aim to have direct and focused communications with the right people as well as keep track of the changes. Significant time efficiency will be created as it reduces redundant email distribution lists. Clarity TeamNet also has specialist tools such as risk management tools and the ability to register and collect submissions and questionnaire from practices which will assist Buckinghamshire CCG in the review and evaluation of practice. Clarity TeamNet provides for individual practices is also high as it helps save time, manage practice effectively and ease the path through CCG and other compliance inspection. Clarity as a provider of digital services is already present in Buckinghamshire - 5 GP practices in Buckinghamshire have Clarity TeamNet where as 30% of GPs in Buckinghamshire are using Clarity GP Appraisal Toolkit. Once the software is installed on the work PC, a user can use a web browser (Internet Explorer, Chrome etc) on their personal device from home and remotely access their work PC. This is a critical requirement to enable remote working for staff who are self-isolated or in the event of a practice closure (eg for a deep clean). 800 licences are being bought on a one year subscription. This is based on the number of users who have personal devices that they can use when working from home. The solution is currently used by 4,500. 	Covid 19 - Immediate LLP	Immediate LLP currently provides 24 hour telemedicine support to 37 care homes across Buckinghamshire in response to the demands of the current environment created by COVID-19. Buks CCG are proposing to extend the contract with Immediate LLP initially with 21 care homes and then rolled to 62 further which would ensure coverage across all care homes and supported living homes within Buckinghamshire. This will help in the provision of 24 hour clinical support and management into all care homes as a direct response to COVID-19. Current cost of service for 37 homes is £248,880 for 12 months. It is proposed to commission: Further 33 homes at a cost of £155,487 for 12 months. Remaining 62 care homes and 20 (20 in total) supported living homes at a cost of £488,534 for 12 months. The service provision comprises: Fully managed digital care service including: Laptop, HD Webcam, camera; Installation services, technical & clinical training; Telephone & video technical support; Comprehensive SLA including on-site engineering visits; Clinical Call Service - 8 clinical consultations per month, which could be aggregated across all operational care homes as required. The service is expected to: Reduce ambulance conveyances and A&E attendance rates and Reduce acute hospital admissions. This is essential during Covid and beyond. The total cost of Immediate supporting 162 homes (37 care homes and supported living) for 12 months would then be £892,881 - of which £684,001 is being requested here. This is expected to be funded on the Covid 19 monthly return.
