The number of NHS GP surgeries or Primary Care Centres currently within NHS Buckinghamshire CCG (most recent data available).</b></p> <p><b>If possible, can you also provide the names and addresses of these properties</b></p>	<p>48 main surgeries, 22 branch surgeries.</p> <p>The CCG can confirm that it does hold information on names and addresses of these properties, but are exempting it under <a href="#">Section 21</a> of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA) as it is reasonably accessible by other means. This is an absolute exemption.</p> <p>I have provided you with a link to the <a href="#">website</a> which will provide you with this information.</p>
<p><b>2. The number of NHS GP surgeries or Primary Care Centres within NHS Buckinghamshire CCG currently (most recent data available) located in previously residential class properties.</b></p> <p><b>For clarity, I mean how many properties currently in the use class D1 (under 1987 UCO), now E(e) (under 2020 UCO), have been previously classed as C3 (dwellinghouses).</b></p>	<p>The CCG does not hold the information in relation to the clarification, but an assessment of the primary care estates suggests 15 are converted houses.</p>
<p><b>3. If held, could you provide equivalent data for the years 2000 and 2010</b></p>	<p>For both 2000 and 2010 there were an additional 4 premises in converted houses, 19 in total.</p>
